

THE FARM LOAN AND RELIEF

We devoutly hope that the Congress, fearful of making We devoutly nope that the congress, learned of maximal beggars of the lot of us by helping the poor through an appropriation of \$25,000,000 for the purchase of food and clothing, the bare necessities of life, will not make the colossal mistake of permitting the proposed \$20,000,000 compromise relief measure to degenerate into a second farm loan thing. This farm loan, which was briefly explained to readers of The Times last w.c.k. is, insofar as farmers of a section such as

this are concerned, but a morsel of food offered, with a string attached whereby it may be snatched back into the safety of the giver's hands.

You farmers can borrow a few paltry dollars, if you will give a first lien against your crop this year to insure the payment of the loan. But, after making a note payable in November of this year and jeopardizing the livelihood to be gained from your farm during 1931, you can use this money only for the purpose of baying seed, fertilizer, or feed for livestock: With this money you cannot buy food or clothing for your family; you can't use it to meet your greatest need.

ny; you can t use it to meet your greatest need.

Our requirements in this section for seed and fertilizer are not great. If you have some livestock for which you have no feed, rather than give a lien against your 1931 crop beef your cattle and make pork of your hogs, or part of them, and thus procure money with which to buy feed and seed or tood and clothing. At any rate, in this way you will remain independent.

On the other hand, if an honest farmer must have a small amount, it occurs to as that he should be able to borrow from Floyd county baths of giving sufficient security. Then he can use the money for feed as well as for feed, for clothing as well

as for seed. The secretary of agriculture intimates that he will liberally construct the meaning of the proposed measure so as, to have it cover fosd and closhing. Well, that matter should not be left up to Mr. Hyde's Dr. Jekyll nature; it should be plainly stated in the bill.

in the bill.

Again, the work of the American Red Cross may be seriously impaired by any ineffectuality possessing the proposed measure. A great deal of arbitration must result: who is in a position to becreek them the relief loan, who must be helped through suright gift?

Supporters of the original bill are half-victorious, halfdefeated. The same applies to its opponents. But this matters little. What is of greatest importance is that the rollet programs does not defeat its own purpose.

"Al Capere," that new publication which glorifies the American criminal, is a remarkable work. Remarkable because it is the last word in the smut into which what we call literation has degenerated, and because it clearly defines the callous, ees of the American literary stomach.

This is the most revolting thing yet produced under the guise of reading matter. The morbid will find it interesting only because of the horrid pictures it contains, showing gangsters, victim's of Capone's bloody rule, sprawled in their own blood, their bodies riddled with bullets. Those who thrive only upon the larid and the sensational will find it interesting only because it depicts the successful reign of a heartless killer whose trail is blazed with crime and bloodshed.

If the publishers had not thought they had fairly well gauged the reading wants of a large percentage of the American public, and had not found this people catering to such trash, it is certain they would not have dabbled in such putridity.

Appearance of "Al Capone" in print is a sad commentory upon our alleged literary tastes.
